

Standard Rabbeted Wicket Doors

Construction: All Rabbeted Wicket Doors are constructed by cutting the Wicket (inner) Door

out of the Main (outer) door. A hardwood 5/8" thick frame is installed as a liner around the cut out for the Wicket using Stainless Steel screws (heads exposed). A 1/2" X 1/2" door stop molding is attached to the liner frame using adhesives and brad nails. The door stop molding can be used on as many edges of the wicket as specified by the customer. The 5/8" thick frame can be machined for a wide variety of hinges and locks. On finished or plastic laminate doors the frame is stained or painted to match. The edges of the wicket door that are to be rabbeted will be fitted with hardwood edges. On finished or plastic laminate doors the edges are stained or painted to match. Custom options are available upon request.

Stiles: (Main Door) 7/8" matching hardwood prior to factory trimming

Faces: All veneer species, medium density overlay (MDO), plastic laminate

Veneer Matching: Available in pairs, sets, & transoms (special matching available)

Cross Bands: High density fiberboard (HDF)

Adhesives: Type 1 (waterproof)

Max Lite Openings: (In the Wicket Door) Must maintain minimum of 8" on stile edges 6" top

and bottom.

Machining/Finishing: Prefit, bevel, & complete factory machining and factory UV finishing available

Warranty: Limited one year (1)
